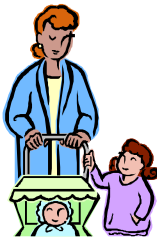

- **Cecilia Muir's** update regarding her garage door opening unexpectedly:

Turns out one of her neighbors was the source of the unexpected opening of their garage door. The neighbors changed the codes on their garage door system and things have been fine since.

On 8/15 she wrote:

"When I first built our house, a couple of times I came back home to find my garage door open. I told Toll Brothers, they explained that all of our garages have a mechanism that changes the code every time the door is opened; therefore, at some point in time one of my neighbors may have the same code at the same time! Anyway, it has happened various times, but not very much until this week. I have been home twice already while hearing my garage door open. I go out and see it opening and then closing. I looked outside to see if a neighbor may have been opening/closing their garage door but so far have missed it. I was wondering if this has happened to any one else? I am worried that if I ever travel, my garage door will be opened and stay that way. Is there any way you can let me know how I may inquire if this has happened to any one before? I do have all my garage openers and have not had any one doing any work here, nor have I lent my garage opener nor fixed it."

- **New Library Hours (NOTE: The new hours start Labor Day Weekend)**

Effective September 6, 2009 (due to \$8.5 million reduction in state funding)

- All 20 branches of CML will be closed on Sundays. Main Library downtown will remain open on Sunday.
- Materials budget has been cut back to 1988 levels
- Hours/pay cuts for staff
- Hours will be cut at all locations. This represents an 18% cutback of hours.

All branches and Main will be open:

- Monday through Thursday: 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
- Friday and Saturday: 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- Sunday: 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. MAIN LIBRARY ONLY

- **New Farmer's Market in Historic Dublin**

Fresh, locally grown products and other farmer's market fare will be available at the Dublin Community Market from **4:30 to 8 p.m. Wednesdays until Oct. 28** at the Dublin Community Church parking lot, 81 W. Bridge St. Pets are not allowed.
