***“By a 4 to 3 vote, Planning and Zoning rejected the design as presented by the Parks and Open Space Department.”***

Thanks to Eric, Tej and Ralph for taking the time to attend the meeting and voicing their concerns, particularly about the park entrance off of Somerset Way. It will be interesting to see the results of a park re-design.
